

The Cherokee County Commission met in regular session on the date specified below. Bills were reviewed and approved as per attached at month-end.

The chairman called the meeting to order and Wayne Cochran opened with prayer.

1. The EMA Director discussed the need to adopt a Hazardous Mitigation Grant Program and to appoint a Local Emergency Planning Committee of local emergency responders. If the committees are not in place by November, 2004, the county will not qualify for future federal funds under various scenarios. Responsibility of appointments lies with County Commissions. The Commission requested more details in the matter before considering action
2. Motion by Harold Woodall seconded by Earl Westbrook to approve a contract with Atlantic Technologies for photographic flights of the county in connection with the property reappraisal function. Reappraisal of all county real estate is to be accomplished in the current year. Motion passed 3-0. The contract amount is 39,584.00.
3. Each Commissioner (except District 1, due to a shortage of funds) pledged 3,000.00 each from Tobacco Tax revenues to the city of Centre to pave the parking area near the concession stand at the park. Council member Henry Wright requested the funds since all county children use the facility.
4. Motion by Earl Westbrook seconded by Dale Welsh to adopt a per diem allowance in lieu of actual food expenses while on county travel passed 3-0. Copy attached.
5. Motion by Dale Welsh seconded by Earl Westbrook to adopt the minutes of the previous meeting passed 3-0.

There being no further business to come before the board, the meeting was adjourned subject to call.
